It's very exciting to report that two more churches, the Kidogo Church and the Kijojo Church, who we've been helping renovate/build were approved and reopened on October 17. This brings to a total of four churches we've been helping which have been reopened since mid-August. Three of the churches had their first service in several years on October 17.



It's exciting that three of the churches have reported many people have accepted Jesus as Savior and are preparing for baptism.

People are grateful and excited to have their church reopened after several years being closed. Some of the churches are having two services to accommodate all the people.

I had the privilege of ministering on five continents, seeing hundreds of thousands hear the Gospel proclaimed and tens of thousands respond to receive Jesus as Savior. It was a difficult decision and a bittersweet moment, but necessary none the less. There have been so many incredible memories for which I am grateful.

But, I will continue to direct Global Partnership Ministries as long as the Lord gives strength and finances. We'll continue ministering in Rwanda and other parts of Africa as the Lord opens doors: and there are many open doors. Thank you for your continued prayer and financial support.

Global Partnership Ministries celebrated ten years of ministry in 2021. It was a challenging year due to COVID restrictions, but the Lord still provided opportunities for the Gospel to be proclaimed and the Kingdom expanded. Even though I couldn't travel, technology enabled me to be very involved in projects and outreaches in Rwanda and Malawi.

This year in Rwanda: four churches were built or renovated and reopened; 7,000 people were provided food during COVID lockdowns; 165 goats and 1100 Bibles were distributed; and more than **38,000** people indicated a decision to receive Jesus as Savior. This through the Love Malawi Festival, the food relief and goat distributions in Rwanda.

- ***Festivals of Hope in Central Rwanda***

The Festivals have been postponed the past two years. We're praying 2022 will be the year to conduct evangelistic outreaches and humanitarian projects in 4-5 mountain villages during July, 2022. This will be accomplished through a partnership with New Life for All from Nigeria and eTeam Global. The Festivals will help build upon what was done in July, 2019 and continue to help strengthen the local churches. ***Projected financial need: \$12,000***



- ***Reopen closed churches in Rwanda***

Thousands of churches remain closed in Rwanda as the believers don't have the finances to build their own building or make necessary renovations to meet government standards. Help us continue assisting churches to reopen.

***Projected financial need for two churches: \$40,000***



- ***Bibles***

There is a great plea for Bibles for kids in Awana Clubs at several churches in Rwanda and new believers from the Food Relief earlier this year. Currently we have **800** requests for Bibles.

***The cost of a Kinyarwandan Bible is \$5 each.***
